Biographical Sketch

Sergeant First Class Scott P. Janise is a Parachute Maintenance Technician serving on the Golden Knights as a Free fall Photographer with the Competition Team.

Janise enlisted in the Army in September 1995. Once his Initial Entry Training was complete he was assigned to Fort Polk, LA, for four years then on to Fort Bragg, NC. He attended the Golden Knight Assessment and Selection Program in the fall of 2002.



Janise took a hiatus from the Knights and volunteered to join 3rd Special Forces Group on a deployment to Afghanistan, in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.

SFC Janise left the Team in 2005 and returned in 2010. Upon his return, he was assigned to the Competition Team as a Free Fall Photographer. Since he began competing, he has won 28 U.S. National Medals and seven World Medals to include a Gold Medal at the 2012 World Cup in the Czech Republic a Silver at the 2012 World Championships in Dubai, United Arab Emirates, the 2013 World Cup in Bosnia, and the 2014 World Championships in the Czech Republic.

Since he began jumping in May 2000 Scott has completed more than 6,900 free fall parachute jumps, 102 static line jumps and 45 tandems.

During his free time he enjoys spending time with his daughter, scuba diving, and motorcycle riding.
