## Biographical Sketch

Sergeant First Class Justin Little is serving on the Gold Demonstration Team as a Demonstration Parachutist.

Justin enlisted more than 14 years ago and attended Basic Training at Ft Benning, GA. Immediately after, his Advanced Individual Training, AIT as an 11B Infantryman was also at Ft. Benning.

Throughout his career, duty stations have included Ft Drum, NY and Hunter Army Airfield, GA where he served as an Airborne Ranger on a number of combat tours to Iraq and Afghanistan. Later he returned to Ft Benning, GA where he attended the Sniper School and to work as a Ranger Instructor until his new assignment to the U.S. Army Parachute Team in 2015.



SFC Justin Little has been on two tours in Iraq and Afghanistan. He has also served one in Bosnia. He has been awarded the Bronze Star medal, Army Commendation, Army Achievement medal, Military Outstanding Volunteer Service medal, Ranger Tab, Combat Infantry Badge, Airborne and Air Assault Badges.

In 2014 Justin applied to the Army Parachute Team's rigorous Assessment and Selection Program and was selected to become a Demonstration Parachutist.

Since learning to skydive in 2012 he has logged more than 750 free fall parachute jumps, and 40 military static line jumps.

In his free time Justin enjoys hunting, fishing, working out and spending time with his son.
