After graduating from the U.S. Army Aviation Center of Excellence in 2019, he was assigned to Camp Humphreys, Korea. While there, he logged more than 250 hours throughout the Republic Of Korea. Since becoming an Aviation Warrant Officer, he has flown the UH-72 Lakota Helicopter, the C-12U (King Air) and the EO-5C (DHC-7). Guest currently flies the teams UV-18C (DHC-6/Twin Otter) and the C-147A (DHC-8).
