Staff Sgt. Dominic Perry serves on the team as a Demonstrator Parachutist on the Gold Team for the U. S. Army Parachute Team.

Perry enlisted in the Army in 2003 and attend basic training at Fort Jackson, S.C. Immediately after basic, he attended advanced individual training to become a Satellite Communications Systems Operator/Maintainer at Fort Gordon, Ga.

His previous duty stations include Fort Benning, Ga. and Fort Bragg, N. C. Perry then went on to serve as a Recruiter in Garner, N. C. Perry served tours in Iraq, Qatar and Afghanistan.
