CPT Matthew Ingerson was commissioned through the Army Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) program as an Aviation Officer in 2011 upon earning a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminology and Criminal Justice from Northern Arizona University.

After the completion of the Aviation Officer Basic Course and the UH-60M aircraft qualification course at Fort Rucker, he was assigned to 2nd Battalion, 82nd Combat Aviation Brigade at Fort Bragg, North Carolina where he served as a Maintenance Platoon Leader. CPT Ingerson deployed to Afghanistan with 1-82 CAB serving as a Company Executive Officer and Battalion Assistant S3.

CPT Ingerson attended the Military Intelligence Captain's Career Course and the Fixed Wing Multiple Engine Qualification Course. CPT Ingerson was then assigned to the 15th Military Intelligence Battalion as the BN S4, Senior Logistic Adviser, followed by taking command of Alpha Company, 15th MI BN, an EMARSS flight Company.



CPT Ingerson is a rated aviator in the UH-60M Blackhawk, C-12 Huron, MC-12 EMARSS G/M/V, and is currently flying the teams UV-18C (Twin Otter) and the C-147A (De Havilland-8-315).
