Biographical Sketch

Sergeant First Class Justin Little is serving as a Demonstrator on the Black Team. Justin enlisted more than 19 years ago and attended Basic Training in January of 2000 at Ft Benning, GA. Immediately after, his Advanced Individual Training, AIT as an 11B Infantryman was also at Ft. Benning.

Throughout his career, duty stations have included Ft Drum, NY and Hunter Army Airfield, GA where he served as an Airborne Ranger on a number of combat tours to Iraq and Afghanistan. Later he returned to Ft Benning, GA where he attended the Sniper School and to work as a Ranger Instructor for four years until his new assignment to the U.S. Army Parachute Team in 2015.



SFC Justin Little has been on two tours in Iraq and Afghanistan. He has also served one in Bosnia. He has been awarded the Bronze Star medal, Army Commendation medal, Army Achievement medal, Military Outstanding Volunteer Service medal, Ranger Tab, Combat Infantry Badge, Airborne and Air Assault Badges.

In 2014 Justin applied to the Army Parachute Team's rigorous Assessment and Selection Program and was selected to become a Demonstration Parachutist. He spent two years on Gold Team, a year on the Four Way Team and is now back to Black Team.

Since learning to skydive in 2012 he has logged more than 3,500 free fall parachute jumps, and 40 military static line jumps.

In his free time Justin enjoys hunting, fishing, working out and most of all spending time with his son.
